Colgate University students were invited to participate in the HEDS Sexual Assault Campus Climate survey. The survey covered topics relating to personal experiences of sexual violence as well as awareness, prevention, and survivor support. Participation was entirely voluntary, and students had the opportunity to skip any questions they chose. Some of the content of this survey is required by the New York State Enough is Enough Law.

This report includes information that may be difficult for survivors of sexual violence or for those close to them.
