

XI. Organization of the University

Offices of the University

Trustees

The Board of Trustees, a body of 35 members, has final responsibility for the conduct of the university. The president of the university is a member of the board and an *ex officio* member of its standing committees including the Executive Committee.

The full board has four regularly scheduled meetings each academic year, including one meeting that has a period of time set aside to permit faculty, students, staff, and alumni to address the board. Questions about the Board of Trustees should be directed to the *secretary of the board*.

President

The President of the University is appointed by the Board of Trustees and is responsible for the general oversight and direction of university instruction and for discipline.

The Vice President and Senior Philanthropic Advisor is responsible for stewardship of university supporters, for advising the president on matters of philanthropy, and for various special presidential projects.

The Secretary of the College also serves as the secretary of the Board of Trustees and provides support to the Office of the President and the board.

Academic Administration

The Dean of the Faculty and Provost is the chief academic officer of the college and has primary responsibility for faculty personnel, curriculum, information technology, and supervision of instructional budgets. As provost, the dean of the faculty is the chief officer of the university in the president's absence.

The Associate Deans of the Faculty assist with general administrative areas under the dean of the faculty.

The Associate Provost has responsibility for academic budgets, federal regulations, and other duties assigned by the provost.

The Dean's Advisory Council, composed of the dean/provost, the five *division directors*, and the associate deans of the faculty, advises the dean of the faculty on matters of academic administration.

Divisions and Academic Departments. The five divisions into which the university is divided are listed below. Each division director is responsible to the dean of the faculty and supervises

the various academic departments and programs in the division.

1. *Humanities*: Art and Art History, the Classics, East Asian Languages and Literatures, English, German, Music, Philosophy, Religion, Romance Languages and Literatures, and Russian
2. *Natural Sciences and Mathematics*: Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Geology, Mathematics, Physics and Astronomy, and Psychology
3. *Social Sciences*: Economics, Education, Geography, History, International Relations, Political Science, and Sociology and Anthropology
4. *University Studies*: Africana and Latin American Studies; Asian Studies; Environmental Studies; Film and Media Studies; Jewish Studies; Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, and Queer Studies; Liberal Arts Core Curriculum; Linguistics; Medieval and Renaissance Studies; Middle Eastern and Islamic Civilization Studies; Native American Studies; Peace and Conflict Studies; Women's Studies; and Writing and Rhetoric
5. *Physical Education, Recreation, and Athletics*: Department of Physical Education, intercollegiate athletic program, intramural and club sports, recreation program, and management of athletic facilities

The Chief Information Technology Officer has responsibility for management of information services, academic computing, administrative computing and networking, and for supervision of information technology staff.

The University Librarian is the chief administrative officer of Case Library and Geyer Center for Information Technology and of George R. Cooley Library, with primary responsibility for library services, collections, including the University Archives, technologies, and personnel.

The Registrar is responsible for keeping all student academic records, supervising the registration process, and certifying students for graduation.

Non-Academic Administration

Admission

The Dean of Admission has responsibility for the admission of first-year and transfer students, and works in close cooperation with the *Office of Financial Aid* in awarding scholarships and other forms of financial assistance.

Alumni Affairs

The Vice President for Alumni Affairs is responsible for the Office of Alumni Affairs, which serves as the liaison between the university and alumni throughout the world. In addition, the office coordinates all activities of the Alumni Council.

Finance and Administration

The Vice President for Finance and Administration leads the division responsible for the university's financial operations, planning, and administrative services. This includes long-range financial planning, budgeting, investment management, capital project finance, accounting and control, risk management, environmental health and safety, financial aid, human resources, community affairs, physical plant, construction and renovation of facilities, purchasing, document and mail services, bookstore, dining, and other miscellaneous auxiliary service enterprises.

The Office of Accounting and Control is responsible for receipt and disbursement of operating funds, including student accounts, financial control systems, and grant and contract accounting.

The Bookstore sells textbooks, trade books, Colgate memorabilia and clothing, and computers and software. The bookstore coordinates a series of readings, community programs, and faculty publication events.

The Office of Budget and Decision Support coordinates the university's planning process for annual and multi-year operating budgets and supports long-range planning and institutional research efforts.

The Office of Buildings and Grounds supervises major construction projects, provides for renovation, repair and maintenance of buildings and building systems, grounds maintenance, custodial services, the vehicular fleet, and operates and maintains campus utilities.

The Office of Community Affairs and Auxiliary Services manages Colgate's relationship with and investments in local and regional communities. The office also oversees the operations of various on-campus auxiliary service enterprises.

Document and Mail Services manages university printing and campus mail, and operates a U.S. Postal Service contract station.

The Environmental Health and Safety Office is responsible for ensuring the health and safety of students, faculty, and staff. The office provides training classes, exposure monitoring, auditing and inspection activities, chemical management, and other miscellaneous compliance services.

The Office of Financial Aid administers the university's financial aid program to undergraduates, assists students and their parents with applications for aid from other sources, and coordinates on-campus student employment.

The Office of Human Resources provides leadership and expertise on human resource issues by serving as internal consultants to university employees in the areas of employment, compensation and benefits administration, training and development, recruitment, and employee/labor relations.

The Investment Office, working with the Endowment Management and Finance Committee of the Board of Trustees, is responsible for overseeing the university's endowment investment portfolio. The office works with and monitors existing managers, evaluates new investment opportunities, coordinates the use of outside consultants and advisory firms, and generates ongoing performance reports.

The Purchasing Office provides purchasing services, administers the university's licensing program, manages the salvage program and central receiving, and coordinates other purchasing and revenue generating programs.

The Office of Risk Management is responsible for initiating and executing the risk management and insurance policies of the university. The office plays a key role in pre/post-loss efforts in order to minimize any adverse effects.

The Treasurer's Office provides analytic and operational support services for the university's endowment investment portfolio, planned giving assets, and capital budgeting. The office is also responsible for coordinating university-wide treasury services such as cash management and short- and long-term financing.

Institutional Advancement

The Vice President for Institutional Advancement is responsible for the Office of Institutional Advancement which includes corporate, foundation, and government relations, annual giving, reunion giving, planned giving, capital support, gift stewardship, Presidents' Club, Parents' Fund, and special events.

Public Relations and Communications

The Vice President for Public Relations and Communications oversees the office responsible for dissemination of news and accurate information as well as official university publications including *The Colgate Scene* and the catalogue.

Student Affairs

The Dean of the College is the chief student affairs officer of the college and is concerned with the overall personal and educational growth of students. The dean of the college coordinates student support programs including the administrative advisers, counseling center, health center, ALANA Cultural Center, career services, Center for Leadership and Student Involvement, residential life, fraternities and sororities, and campus safety, among others.

Affirmative Action Compliance

The Vice President and Dean of Diversity, Keenan Grenell (105 McGregor, 315-228-6161), oversees implementation of the university's EEO/AA plan and compliance with the Affirmative Action Policy. The vice president also oversees compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws prohibiting discrimination in employment.

The Staff Affirmative Action Officer (AAO) monitors progress against affirmative action goals for administrative, professional, and staff positions; monitors and provides training in fair recruiting practices; and assists the dean for institutional diversity in developing and implementing principles and goals set forth in Colgate's affirmative action plan.

The Associate Provost, Patricia St. Leger (105 McGregor, 315-228-7224), oversees compliance with Title IX of the Educational Amendments of 1972.

Affirmative Action Policy

Colgate University is committed to policies of affirmative action designed to increase the employment of historically underrepresented groups in our whole work force and of women on the faculty. We aspire to broaden the diversity of our educational community. We recognize that this will require that we offset geographical isolation in order to create a rich representation of racial/ethnic minorities in order to attract other members of these groups. We also aim through affirmative action to help overcome the effects of both conscious and unconscious discrimination as well as any under-representation experienced by these groups and by women.

Disabilities Compliance

The Director of Academic Support and Disability Services, Lynn Waldman (The Center for Learning, Teaching, and Research, 315-228-7375), oversees compliance with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990.
