

Colgate University Supplemental Graduation Requirement Worksheet

Students are responsible for ensuring that all graduation requirements are fulfilled. This form is provided as a tool for tracking progress toward graduation. Though university policy does not require that students complete this form, it is suggested that it be used to facilitate the advising process. Individual departments, programs, or advisers may require completion and review of the form as an element of discussion during the major declaration process.

In order to be eligible to graduate, students must fulfill all requirements listed below.

- 32.00 course credits (minimum):** This includes courses completed at Colgate (or on Colgate study groups) as well as Advanced Placement, approved pre-matriculation credits, and other approved transfer credits counting toward the Colgate degree. Please note that **no more than 2.00 course credits from fractional add-on credits may count toward this requirement.** (Example: If you have earned 2.75 add-on credits, you must earn at least 32.75 course credits to graduate.)

- Grade point average (GPA) requirement:** A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 is required, as is a minimum GPA of 2.00 in the major. (Refer to individual departmental/program information in the *Colgate Catalogue* to determine how the major GPA is calculated.)

- Residency requirement:** Students entering as first-years must complete seven semester in residence at Colgate. Colgate study groups count toward the fulfillment of this requirement.

- Writing requirement:** Students are notified prior to first-term registration if they are required to take a Writing and Rhetoric course while at Colgate.

- Language requirement:** Students are notified prior to first-term registration if they are required to complete the language requirement while at Colgate.
