## Sustainability of the North Country

August 16-20, 2023

In this experiential pre-orientation trip, you will have the opportunity to take a deep dive into sustainability in New York's North Country on a three-day excursion from the Tug Hill Plateau to the expansive Adirondack Park. After a primer in sustainability at Colgate in the on-campus Community Garden, our outings will take us to the state's largest wind farm, on a hike in the Adirondack High Peaks, and to a working sustainable farm. Connect with other incoming students as we bond over personal climate experiences, hike in unique habitats, eat sustainable foods, and practice zero-waste habits. All are welcome, whether you consider yourself a novice in sustainability or a long-time sustainability champion. After returning to campus, you will start off on a more sustainable path with a crew of like-minded friends as you embark on your first year at Colgate.



## Wilderness Adventure

August 5–10, 2023

August 15-20, 2023

Each August, more than a quarter of first-year students choose a Wilderness Adventure as their pre-orientation program. For more than 30 years, these trips have taken place in the Adirondack State Park, which, at six million acres, is larger than Yellowstone, Everglades, Glacier, and Grand Canyon national parks combined. The Outdoor Education (OE) staff hopes you'll be able to experience one of their backpacking, canoeing, sea kayaking, rock climbing, mountain biking, or sampler trips in the Adirondack State Park. Whether you have lots of outdoor experience or have never camped before, the number of activities and range of trip difficulty levels mean that we have a trip that's just right for you. No previous experience is necessary, and significant financial assistance is available.
